

FACTS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Camp McSaubia is open to all boys and girls ages five to thirteen. **Children must be 5 years old by June 1, 2010.** All sessions are open to residents and non-residents of Charlevoix. Sessions are five days in length, running Monday to Wednesday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:15 p.m., Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., Friday, Thursday is an overnight. Before & After care is from 8:00 a.m. to 5:10 p.m. Monday through Friday (*\$5.00 for each additional five minutes*). Transportation is the responsibility of the camper's parents.



All children should bring a sack lunch, a beverage, their bathing suit, towel and their energy! *Because of Zebra mussels and stones, sandals or aqua shoes are required to wear in the water. Please label all belongings with child's first and last name.*

IMPORTANT

Due to many of our campers having a peanut allergy, we are asking that if you send anything in your camper's lunch that contains peanuts(peanut butter, cookies, trail mix, etc.) that you let your child's counselor know. *Any child with special needs must be accompanied by an assistant at all times.*
